Important Information

- → Students will report to school at their regular time. Students will have the opportunity to eat breakfast prior to leaving. We will leave the middle school at approximately 8:30am for Six Flags. We will arrive back at Winslow Middle School at approximately 6:30pm. ***Parents must be at the middle school by 6:30pm to pick up their child. There will not be buses home from the middle school.
- → One meal is included in the cost of the trip. Students may bring money for food or other items. Six Flags is cashless. There are kiosks throughout the park to deposit cash onto a spending card.
- → School appropriate attire is required. Students will be given a trip shirt that must be worn at all times, and cannot be altered in any way. We will not be doing the water park so no swim attire is needed.
- → Students are responsible for all items they bring on the trip. All bags are subject for checking.
