Important Information

- Students who have a school fine, are in violation of the 4-suspension policy or cellphone/electronics policy will not be permitted to attend. Any student who becomes ineligible after turning in their money will not be issued a refund.
- Students will report to school at their regular time. Students will have the opportunity to eat breakfast prior to leaving. We will leave the middle school at approximately 8:30am for Six Flags. We will arrive back at Winslow Middle School at approximately 6:30pm. *****Parents must be at the middle school by 6:30pm to pick up their child. There will not be buses home from the middle school.**
- One meal is included in the cost of the trip. Students may bring money for food or other items. Six Flags is cashless. There are kiosks throughout the park to deposit cash onto a spending card.
- School appropriate attire is required. Students will be given a trip shirt that must be worn at all times, and cannot be altered in any way. We will not be doing the water park so no swim attire is needed.
- Students are responsible for all items they bring on the trip. All bags are subject for checking.

Permission Form: Field Trips, Social Events, and Class Trips

The Board of Education recognizes the value of field trips, social events and class trips all of which serve to enrich and enhance the school experience of pupils in this district. Field trips are directly related to the curriculum of the schools and are thus an extension of the teaching and learning that daily occurs in the classroom. Social events and class trips are not extensions of the curriculum and generally are only indirectly or marginally related to instruction. Participation in social events and class trips is not a right and may be denied to any pupils for any reason deemed appropriate by the school principal. Any student who has demonstrated disregard for school rules may be denied participation in social events and class trips. **Students participating in field trips, social events, and class trips are subject to the same code of conduct that applies during the school day. Pupils are subject to the authority of teachers and chaperones at all times. Students, who possess or consume alcohol or drugs during a trip or event, will be returned home in the company of a chaperone or the student's parents or legal guardians. Any expenses incurred by the school district in arranging the early dismissal of a student from a trip or event will be the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.** Efforts will be made to accommodate students who require the administration of medication during the trip or event. When a pupil attends a school-sponsored event at which the administration of medication may be required, and the school nurse cannot be in attendance, the pupil's parents(s) or legal guardians(s) will be invited to attend the trip or event. If neither the school nurse nor the parent/guardian can attend, and the student does not have permission to self-administer medication, and the risk of harm to the student is substantial, the pupil may be excused from the event.
