Permission Form: Field Trips, Social Events, and Class Trips		
The Board of Education recognizes the value of field trips, social events and class trips all of which serve to enrich and enhance the school experience of pupils in this district. Field trips are directly related to the curriculum of the schools and are thus an extension of the teaching and learning that daily occurs in the classroom. Social events and class trips are not extensions of the curriculum and generally are only indirectly or marginally related to instruction. Participation in social events and class trips is not a right and may be denied to any pupils for any reason deemed appropriate by the school principal. Any student who has demonstrated disregard for school rules may be denied participation in social events and class trips. Students participating in field trips, social events, and class trips are subject to the same code of conduct that applies during the school day. Pupils are subject to the authority of teachers and chaperones at all times. Students, who possess or consume alcohol or drugs during a trip or event, will be returned home in the company of a chaperone or the student's parents or legal guardians. Any expenses incurred by the school district in arranging the early dismissal of a student from a trip or event will be the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian. Efforts will be made to accommodate students who require the administration of medication during the trip or event. When a pupil attends a school-sponsored event at which the administration of medication may be required, and the school nurse cannot be in attendance, the pupil's parents(s) or legal guardians(s) will be invited to attend the trip or event. If neither the school nurse nor the parent/guardian can attend, and the student does not have permission to self-administer medication, and the risk of harm to the student is substantial, the pupil may be excused from the event.
