





Social events and class trips are not extensions of the curriculum and generally are only indirectly or marginally related to instruction. Participation in social events and class trips is not a right and may be denied to any pupils for any reason deemed appropriate by the school principal. Any student who has demonstrated disregard for school rules may be denied participation in social events and class trips. Students participating in field trips, social events, and class trips are subject to the same code of conduct that applies during the school day. Pupils are subject to the authority of teachers and chaperones at all times. Students, who possess or consume alcohol or drugs during a trip or event, will be returned home in the company of a chaperone or the student's parents or legal guardians. Any expenses incurred by the school district in arranging the early dismissal of a student from a trip or event will be the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian. Efforts will be made to accommodate students who require the administration of medication during the trip or event. When a pupil attends a school-sponsored event at which the administration of medication may be required, and the school nurse cannot be in attendance, the pupil's parents(s) or legal guardians(s) will be invited to attend the trip or event. Dear Parents/Guardians and the Class of 2030,

The 2025-2026 school year will have many memorable experiences and educational opportunities for your child. It is hard to believe we are mentioning the Eighth Grade Promotion Ceremony, but we want to be sure you have ample time to prepare. In an effort to make the Eighth Grade Promotion Ceremony a memorable event for the students and their families, we have outlined specific guidelines for the event. The ceremony will begin promptly at 6:00pm on June 17, 2026 in the Winslow Township High School Gymnasium.

#### ~ Eligibility for the Ceremony:

Participation for the ceremony has been reserved for those students who have met all academic, attendance, and disciplinary requirements. A student is not eligible for participation if he/she:

- 1. Has not met the academic requirements.
- 2. Has an absence record of more than 16 days, as described by the board policy.
- 3. Is in violation of the 4-suspension policy, or the electronic device policy, as described by the handbook and board policy.
- 4. Has an outstanding fine/fee of any type.

#### ~Attire:

Students will wear graduation gowns to the ceremony. Gowns will be given out 8th period the day of the ceremony. The graduation gowns are property of Winslow Township School District and must be returned upon the completion of the ceremony. At the conclusion of the promotional ceremony, the gowns will be collected. Please take all photos before the ceremony; the students will not be exiting the gym with their gowns. Students should also wear school appropriate attire underneath their gowns due to this being a school function. (No jeans, nothing revealing, all skirts/dresses should be no higher than one inch above the knee and should be no longer than the graduation gown, and comfortable shoes, but no sneakers due to walking a distance in their graduation gowns.)

#### ~ Tickets:

Each student will be given 2 tickets along with their gown during 8th period on June 17, 2026. No extra tickets will be provided for any reason. You must have the tickets with you in order to enter the ceremony, NO EXCEPTIONS. Reserved seating for people with disabilities is available. If these tickets are lost, they will not be replaced. Seating in the gymnasium is limited and is based on room capacity, fire code, and number of students. A live stream link will be posted to the website on June 16th for additional friends and family to view!

#### ~Arrival:

Students should arrive at 5:00pm. They should be dropped off at the cafeteria entrance of the high school (loop front by the track) and will be directed to where we are lining up. Parents/guardians will enter the ceremony using the Gymnasium entrance (back of building).

#### ~ Parking:

Parents/guardians are asked to park in the lots adjacent to the football field, in the areas in the back of the High School behind the auditorium and gymnasium, or in the Middle School parking lot. All guests must enter through the Jordan Burrows Gymnasium doors.
